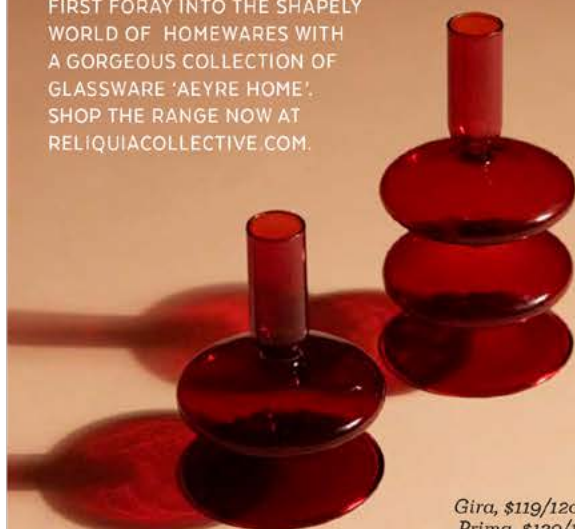

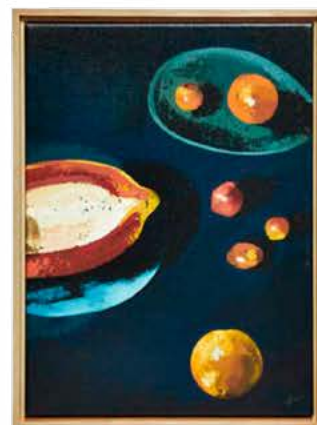

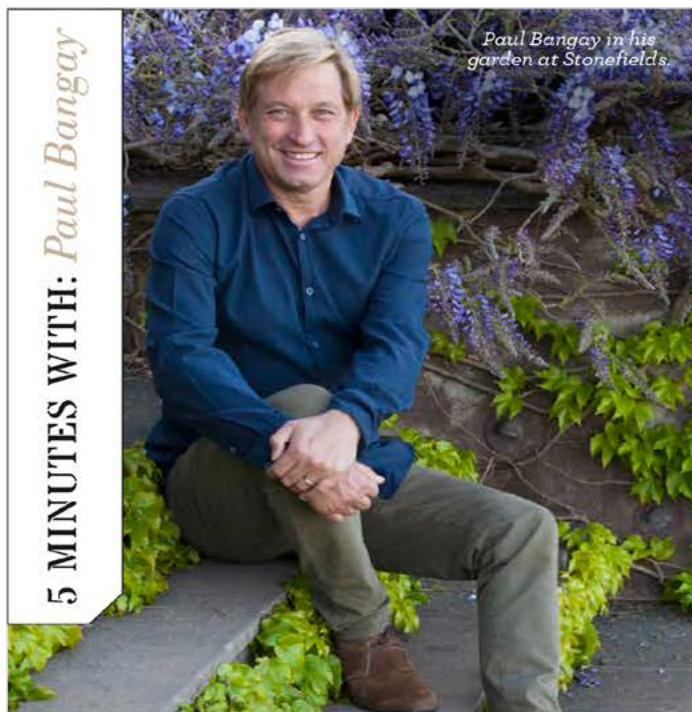

AWARD-WINNING AUSTRALIAN LANDSCAPE DESIGNER PAUL BANGAY, ABOVE, OFFERS A RARE INSIGHT INTO THE STUNNING GARDEN ON HIS 'STONEFIELDS' ESTATE IN REGIONAL VICTORIA

What is your new book, 'Stonefields by the Seasons' about?

Paul: "It's all about living through four seasons in one garden. We have very distinct seasons at Stonefields and each is different and unique, the garden is mature now and I felt it was a good time to document it."

What do you hope to achieve through the release of this new book?

"To show people how a garden can change through the seasons. It's been 10 years since the last book on Stonefields was released and the difference is immense. People appreciate seeing what can be achieved in a short time."

What do you love most about garden and landscape design?

"It's always changing, never static. Landscape design is my entire life; I spend all my time travelling and seeing gardens all over the world and my style evolves with the way we live and along with international trends."

Where do you find inspiration?

"Travel and experimentation."

What is the key to becoming a great gardener?

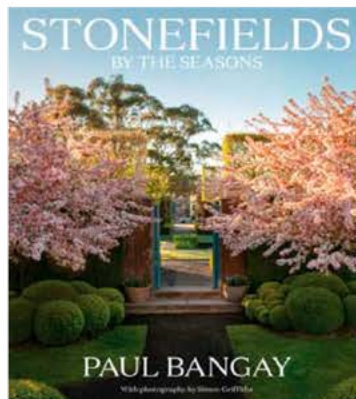
"Patience and humility, and to never believe that you've made it and can't learn anything further."

What is the most important lesson you have learned during your career?

"Always look to expand your mind, learn new plants, new styles, travel to countries that challenge you."

What are the most important things every gardener needs for their garden to grow to its full potential?

"Good soil is key, lots and lots of homemade compost. An appropriate planting design: only choose plants suitable for your climate. And maintenance, no garden is maintenance-free. The act of gardening is a great skill we should all learn."
